NEXT STEPS:

[CONNECT] Pray For the Hurting: Spend some time praying to God for a friend or family member that is currently experiencing difficulties in life. Sacrifice your time.

[GROW] Thank God: Because of Jesus we are all blessed. What can you take time to simply express gratitude to God for even in a time of hardship?

[SERVE] Join a Life Group: *Make a comment to other Christians, helping one another to grow strong in our faith.*

"A NEW PURPOSE IN LIFE" Romans 15:1-21

HOW TO USE MY INFLUENCE FOR THE KINGDOM OF GOD?

Romans 15:1-3 We who are strong have an obligation to bear with the failings of the weak, and not to please ourselves. ² Let each of us please his neighbor for his good, to build him up. ³ For Christ did not please himself, but as it is written, "The reproaches of those who reproached you fell on me."

> LIVE <u>SACRIFICIALLY</u> TO BUILD OTHERS UP.

Romans 15:4 ⁴ For whatever was written in former days was written for our instruction, that through endurance and through the encouragement of the Scriptures we might have hope.

> RESPOND TO LIFE WITH CONSISTENT HOPE .

Romans 15:5-7 ⁵ May the God of endurance and encouragement grant you to live in such harmony with one another, in accord with Christ Jesus, ⁶ that together you may with one voice glorify the God and Father of our Lord Jesus Christ. ⁷ Therefore welcome one another as Christ has welcomed you, for the glory of God.

> LIVE IN <u>FAMILY</u> WITH OTHERS THAT ARE FOCUSED ON JESUS.

> GET A <u>BIGGER</u> PURPOSE.

Romans 15:8-9 ⁸ For I tell you that Christ became a servant to the circumcised to show God's truthfulness, in order to confirm the promises given to the patriarchs, ⁹ and in order that the Gentiles might glorify God for his mercy.

Romans 15:14-21 ¹⁴ I myself am satisfied about you, my brothers, that you yourselves are full of goodness, filled with all knowledge and able to instruct one another. ¹⁵But on some points I have written to you very boldly by way of reminder, because of the grace given me by God^{16} to be a minister of *Christ Jesus to the Gentiles in the priestly service of the gospel* of God, so that the offering of the Gentiles may be acceptable, sanctified by the Holy Spirit. ¹⁷ In Christ Jesus, then, I have reason to be proud of my work for God. ¹⁸ For I will not venture to speak of anything except what Christ has accomplished through me to bring the Gentiles to obedience—by word and deed, ¹⁹ by the power of signs and wonders, by the power of the Spirit of God—so that from Jerusalem and all the way around to Illyricum I have fulfilled the ministry of the gospel of Christ; ²⁰ and thus I make it my ambition to preach the gospel, not where Christ has already been named, lest I build on someone else's foundation, ²¹ but as it is written, "Those who have never been told of him will see, and those who have never heard will understand."
